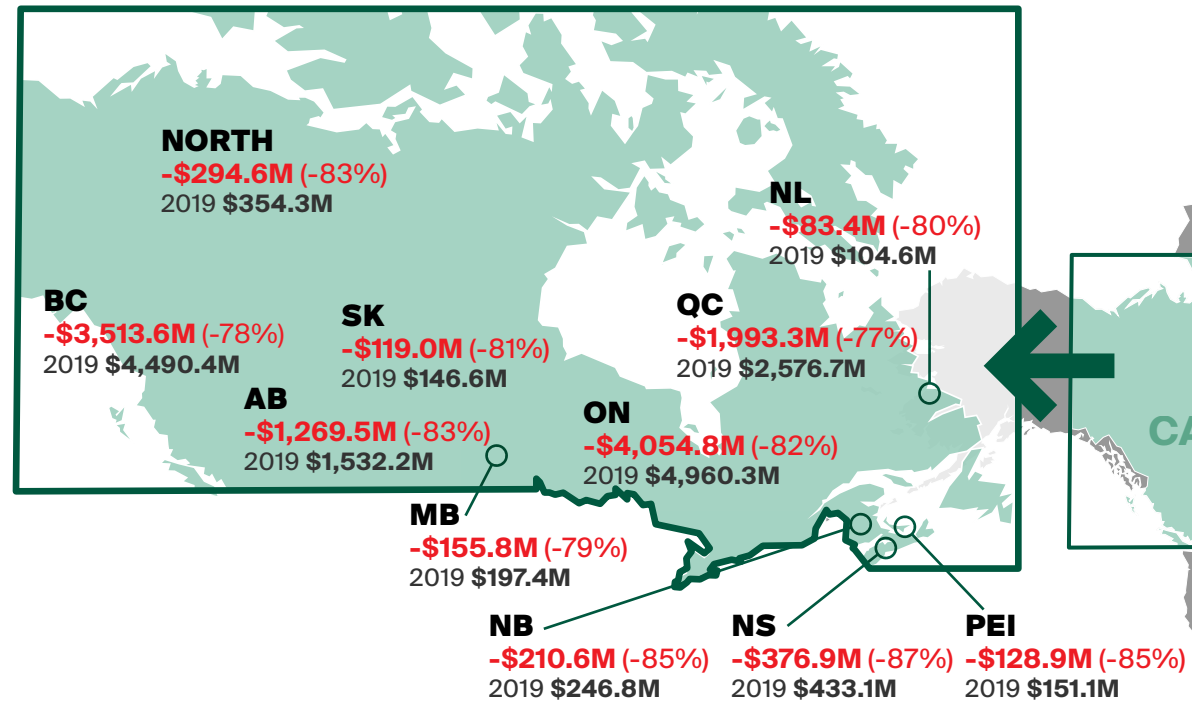

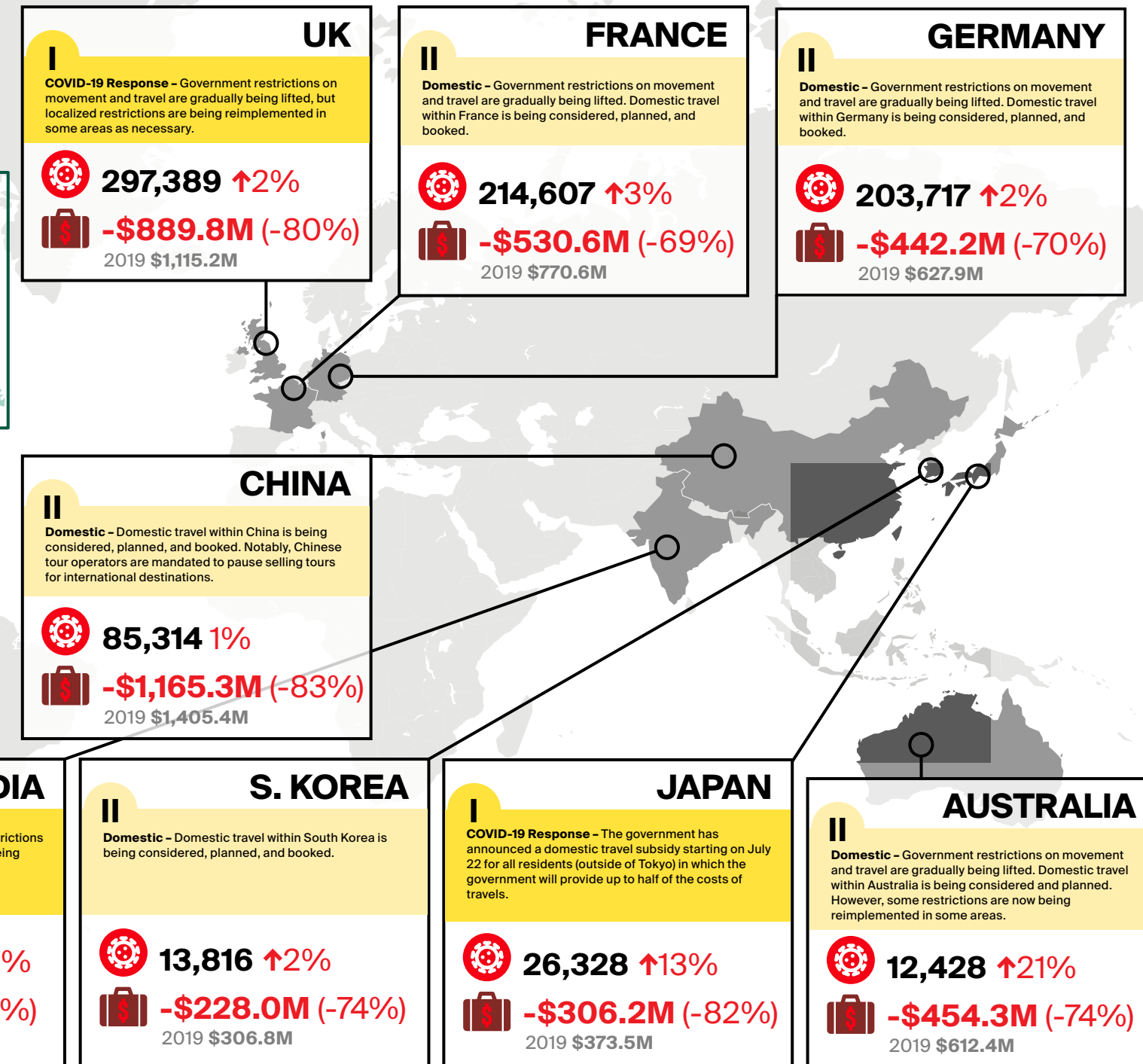


Total confirmed COVID-19 cases as of July 21<sup>2</sup> ↑ = % increase compared to previous week<sup>3</sup>
